



**Request for Proposals
Specialized Technical Monitoring Services**

1. RESOURCES SOURCE

The Central American Bank for Economic Integration (CABEI), as part of the services it provides to its beneficiary partner countries, is providing total financing for the selection and hiring of a consulting firm that will provide Specialized Technical Monitoring Services to the BISP, within the framework of the Belize Integral Security Programme (BISP) for which CABEI has approved the resources.

2. EXECUTING AND CONTRACTING AGENCY OF THE TENDER PROCESS

- 2.1.** The Ministry of Economic Transformation (MET) is the Executing Agency of the Contracting Party. It intends to use a portion of the funds of this financing to make eligible payments under the Contract for which this invitation to Bid is being issued.
- 2.2.** The Belize Integral Security Programme is responsible for this selection process, for which it invites eligible consulting firms to submit proposals to develop the consultancy.
- 2.3.** The consulting firm will be selected through an international competition in accordance with the procedures of the Central American Bank for Economic Integration established in the Policy for the Obtaining of Goods, Works, Services, and Consultancies with CABEI Resources and its Norms for Application found on the following Website:

3. PRESENTATION OF THE COMPETITION PROCESS

- 3.1.** The General objective of the consultancy to be carried out is to provide Specialized Technical Monitoring Services to the BISP. The Contractor shall function as a dynamic element in the execution of the Program, serving as a link between the Executing Agency, the Executing Unit and CABEI, facilitating compliance with the Bank's procedures and regulations, making available, when necessary, the appropriate personnel to carry out the required activities and promoting the streamlining of the processes associated with the Program, as well as the periodic monitoring of infrastructure projects and goods that require it.
- 3.2.** The contractor makes available to interested parties all the documentation related to this consultancy that is necessary for the preparation of the proposals.
